The Kansas City Retriever Club is hosting a training day on Saturday, February 4th for our membership instead of the Fun Trial. Since we will be on private land, the request has been made that it only be open to club members. BUT, if you have a friend wanting to join in on the training and the camaraderie, membership applications will be on the grounds.

The new venue will be in Oak Grove, MO (28 miles East from downtown Kansas City). We have obtained the use of very beautiful training grounds for this event. Oak Grove has many restaurants and fast food places, in case you forget to bring food or soda.

Plan on arriving between 9:00-9:30am. Don't forget to bring your e-collar. Even though we will be in the city limits, we have permission from the land owner, mayor and city attorney to use dead birds and poppers. Bring your bumpers if you want to use for training.

Directions are from Kansas City:

Take I-70 East to exit 28 (Oak Grove), turn South (right) and take Broadway through town to 15th Street. At 15th Street, turn West (right). Go approximately ½ mile to Oak Lane. At Oak Lane, turn South (left) and as you go up the drive, you are on the property. Look for the brown wooden fence. We will try and have a sign for you at the property. 2001 SW Oak Lane

Take 50 Hwy East to F Hwy (Oak Grove, I understand there is a yellow caution flashing light at the turn), turn North (left) and continue to Oak Grove. Go to 15th Street. At 15th Street, turn West (left). Go approximately ½ mile to Oak Lane. At Oak Lane, turn South (left) and as you go up the drive, you are on the property. Look for the brown wooden fence. We will try and have a sign for you at the property. 2001 SW Oak Lane
